Issue: Accessible toilet in firefighters' living quarters.

Analysis: The applicant is requesting a waiver from providing an accessible toilet in the firefighters' living quarters. The project is an existing 7,952 gross square foot building, and during the renovation, the 4,172 square foot living quarters will be upgraded and the engine bays reduced by 290 gross square feet. Existing toilet rooms are not accessible, and during the alteration two toilet rooms and showers will be made accessible. The project will cost \$600,000.

Project Progress:

The project is under design.

Items to be Waived:

One accessible toilet room, as required by Section 11-4.1.6(3)(e)(iii):

11-4.1.6(3)(e)(iii): When existing toilet or bathing facilities are being altered and are not made accessible, signage complying with Sections 11-4.30.1, 11-4.30.2, 11-4.30.3, 11-4.30.5 and 11-4.30.7 shall be provided indicating the location of the nearest accessible toilet or bathing facility within the facility.

Waiver Criteria: There is no specific guidance for a waiver of this requirement in the code. The Commission's current rule, authorized in Section 553.512, Florida Statutes, provides criteria for granting waivers and allows consideration of unnecessary or extreme hardship to the applicant if the specific requirements were imposed.

The hardship is a result of a condition that is not accounted for under the code. A fire station is a facility used mainly to house firefighting equipment and firefighters. The minimum requirements to qualify is Florida Statutes 633.30-633.35, govern a firefighter. Under these sections, there is a requirement that a firefighter be in good physical condition as outlined by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard 1582. Not under any circumstances would an individual with a disability be qualified to be a Firefighter. Therefore, making the requirement of the accessibility code impractical for those areas of the fire station that would be open to the public.

The following comments pertain to: 1) New Fire Station #48, City of Clearwater. As per Federal

Register 28 CFR Part 35 Section 35.151 and 36 CFR Part 1101. The Department of Justice's Title II Regulations give state and local governments the option of choosing between designing, constructing, or altering their facilities in conformance with UFAS or with ADAAG. We choose to use UFAS which includes an Occupancy Classification Section that is not included in the ADA. This Section 4.1.4 (5) deals with fire stations and states that the application of the code should apply to: "All Areas for Which the Intended Use will Require Public Access or Which May Result in Employment of Physically Handicapped Persons." Based on this, we contend that the restroom for the firefighters' dormitory does not need to comply with accessibility requirements.

Please note that we have provided an accessible toilet room where the public will have access.
