

FBC 2012 WORKPLAN PRIORITIZATION RANKING EXERCISE RESULTS

Commissioners were asked to rank each of ten (10) key *Workplan* tasks on a five-point continuum/scale where a 5 equals the highest level of priority and a 1 equals the lowest level of priority. Members were asked to rank the priority of each task independently and not in relation to the other tasks. Each of the *Workplan* task's rankings were tallied and arranged in order of highest priority (1) to lowest priority (10). The ranking results ranged from a high of 4.53 to a low of 2.80 out of 5.

- Green issues are easily handled by adopting ICC.
- Identify Florida specific issues submitted by workgroups for review in the next code cycle since they will all sunset if not carried into the I-Code.
- Would like to see how current budget is working (and I believe it is working based on last Budget Committee meeting) before we go in that direction.
- Address common standards for continuing education and course approvals across licensing boards.
- Continue coordination with the Florida Fire Prevention Code.
- I think threshold inspectors should be either used more as the building industries inspectors or we should do away with them except in special instances. 24 hour jobs high security etc.
