Ms. Peters welcomed everyone to the concurrent teleconference meeting of the Roofing TAC and Structural TAC.

# **Roll Call:**

Ms. Peters performed roll call for the Roofing TAC. A quorum was determined with 7 members present.

# **Agenda Approval:**

Mr. Boyer entered a motion to approve the agenda for today's meeting. Mr. Cone seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 7 to 0.

### Approval of the Minutes from February 6, 2017

Mr. Boyer entered a motion to approve the minutes from the February 6, 2017 meeting as posted. Mr. Logan seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 7 to 0.

# To review and accept interim draft report for the research project titled "Corrosion of Roofing Fasteners":

Mr. Madani provided a short summary of the report for the TACs.

Kurt Gurley, UF presented phase four of this project. He provided detail on the additional tile fastener testing and ratings of corrosion and explanation of the testing results to date.

# TAC comments:

Mr. Makar inquired about the NOA and availability of the identification of the products used in testing.

Mr. Gurley stated they might be able to produce those records.

Mr. Cone inquired about the testing with the tile fasteners and the comparison to the worse case results. In addition he stated he understood the testing would not identify any product titles or manufacturer. He stated by giving this information you are singling out manufacturers.

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## TAC comments (cont.):

Mr. Zehnal stated that he agreed with Mr. Cone and that no information should be released as to who the manufactures used in this project are.

Mr. Swope stated he echoed Mr. Cone and Mr. Zehnal.

Mr. Buckner stated he had to agree with Mr. Cone, Mr. Zehnal and Mr. Swope.

Ms. Hammonds stated that this type of information is not to be released unless there is a public records request and the information was published with the manufacturer's names.

Mr. Gurley stated only the researchers have seen the names of the product manufactures. The names have not been published anywhere and will not be.

Public Comment: none

Mr. Zehnal entered a motion to accept the report. Mr. Boyer seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 7 to 0.

To review and accept interim draft report for research project titled "Evaluation of the Cost Impact of Florida's Specific Changes to 2015 I-Code Changes (Prescriptive Code Changes)":

Mr. Madani provided background on this project.

Dr. Raymond Issa provided detail of the report with a power point presentation. He then provided the costs impact of code modification involving roofing.

# **TAC Comment:**

Mr. Cone stated that there is an "X" in the wrong column under 7051 and 7052 should be in the decrease column.

Mr. Madani stated there will be another chance for the TACs to review before the final report is published.

Mr. Schock provided some information on a motion of the Fire TAC; he stated it does not provide the actual cost benefit.

Mr. Madani stated this study is only to show the increase/decrease in cost to construction, not cost benefit study.
