Ms. Peters welcomed everyone to the concurrent meeting of the Swimming Pool TAC and Electrical TAC.

Roll Call:

Ms. Peters performed roll call for the Swimming Pool TAC. A quorum was determined with 8 members present.

Agenda Approval:

Mr. O'Connor entered a motion to approve the agenda for today's meeting as posted. Mr. Pabst seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 8 to 0.

Approval of Minutes from July 28, 2017.

Mr. Vincent advised of corrections needed starting on page 3.

Mr. Pabst entered a motion to approve the minutes from July 28, 2017 as amended. Mr. Vincent seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 8 to 0.

To review and accept final draft report for research project titled "Evaluation of the Cost Impact of Florida's Specific Changes to 2015 I-Code Changes (Prescriptive Code Changes)":

Mr. Madani provided background of this report and that it was researched to determine the cost impact on Florida Specific changes.

Dr. Raymond Issa provided detail of the report with a power point presentation. He began with the Pool Code cost changes and then provided Electrical Code costs changes.

Swimming Pool and Electrical TAC Comments:

Corky Williams inquired how the \$150.00 figure for the GFCI was obtained.

Dr. Issa advised the figures were obtained from electrical contractors.

Jordan Clarkson inquired about changes on the initial report as it did not show figures but stated minimal costs.

Dr. Issa stated that the report has been updated to reflect actual figures.

Swimming Pool and Electrical TAC Comments (cont.):

Mr. Clarkson also inquired potential bonding costs.

Mr. O'Connor entered a motion to approve the report. Mr. Pabst seconded the motion.

Mr. Clarkson asked if they are voting on the report as is or on the report with changes discussed earlier.

Mr. Madani explained that this is a second draft and the TAC will review before the final report is presented to the Commission.

There was no public comment.

The TAC passed the motion unanimously with a vote of 8 to 0.

Mr. Madani stated they were trying to get a quorum for the March 21st teleconference. Members James Batts, Corky Williams, and Mark Pabst all stated they would be on the call. There was a question on the content of the meeting. Mr. Madani provided the detail of the meeting.

Additional TAC Comments:

David Rice questioned the Florida Building Code Residential discussion at the last meeting and changes to Chapter 34 through 43.

Mr. Madani explained how the Florida Specific changes began and how they are completed today. He further advised that he would be glad to go through the entire process with Mr. Rice at his convenience via telephone.

April Hammonds, Esq. explained that all provisions sunset and previously they had been reserved so the International Code is the base code so if someone wanted to submit a recommendation that any area be reserved they could but that has not been done. She further stated unless someone makes that recommendation there will be no change.

Mr. Madani advised of how the reviews are completed and that all information is present on the BCIS.

Mr. Rice stated no one has submitted any changes or comments.

The comment deadlines were given.

Mr. Madani stated he would be glad to discuss timelines for comments and the glitch process with him via a phone call.

Public Comment:

Joe Belcher asked about the comment deadline for the April 4, 2017 meeting.

April Hammonds, Esq. explained the hard deadline.

Final Roll Call:

Ms. Peters performed the final roll call all 8 members were remaining on the call.
