This testing data must conform to the 19 current Florida Building Code as it relates to the standards for 20 individual insulation products and meets standards set forth by 21 the American Society for Testing and Materials and comply with 22 the Federal Trade Commission's regulations in 16 C.F.R. part 23 460. 24 This testing data must be provided to building code

officials, building professionals, and homeowners upon request.

Evaluation reports may only be used as supporting documentation
to the test data. The report must be for a singular product and
contain the test lab where a product was tested, the test report
number, and the date the testing took place. The test lab must
be accredited by a national organization such as the American
Association for Laboratory Accreditation (A2LA) or the National
Voluntary Laboratory Accreditation Program of the National
Institute of Standards and Technology.
(3) Failure to comply with this section constitutes a
violation of the Florida Deceptive and Unfair Trade Practices
Act, part II of chapter 501.
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
