Good evening Eric,

Hope the day has treated you well.

Attached is our proposal to renovate the 2nd floor of your new building, along with a floor plan that we based the cost estimate on (don't worry about the design - just needed to base it on something) and the previous elevator cost for your old building. We weren't sure if you wanted us to put that together as one proposal or not..... In reality a full sized elevator for your new building is probably closer to \$80,000 - not quite as difficult to do as the old building would have been. We also estimated that a ramp - which would be approximately 126' of run is going to cost about \$ 30,000.00. Your best bet, if you need/want to make your new building accessible is probably more of a residential type elevator. Something like that would be around \$25,000.
