The cost of a full commercial elevator is significant, as well as the space requirements in the plan for the shaft and equipment. Like all costs, there are variations for geographic location as well as trends in the economic market that can drive the cost. Below is a chart, courtesy of The Means Report, published by RSMeans, the industry's leading construction cost estimating resource. Cost of Hydraulic 2Stop Elevator The installed cost of these units range from \$65,000 to \$75,000, depending on the location, and the trend right now is in a down cycle. This data is also very consistent with installed costs for similar elevator units in projects that we have designed in both Colorado and Texas. The highest average cost for these units has reached over \$90,000 in the last two years, and is likely to return to those levels in the future.
