The Building Officials interpretation is a gauge has to be used to determine if the water supply system for a residential dwelling is not leaking (no gauge fails inspection). Furthermore, inspector wants a clean new gauge on each unit, the slightest rust or construction debris invalidates the gauges capability to determine the system is TIGHT and leak proof. I feel and most jurisdictions we work in through out Central Florida agree, when the dwelling is hooked up to the municipalities and is under working pressure a gauge is not required according to section 2503.7 Florida Residential Plumbing Code

- In response to 2nd more information needed The working pressure being provided to the homes in the new subdivision varies depending on the time of day and whether or not the pumps are running, that's why a gauge is irrelevant and not required according to Florida Building Code Residential Plumbing P2503.7
