The telecommunication service is for public cellular carriers such as AT&T, MetroPCS, Verizon, T-Mobile, etc.... As far as emergency, in the event of equipment failure, the people with cellphones will not be able to call 911. In addition, emergency response units will not be able to triangulate the cellphone holder's position. It is not clear whether or not this will be considered an emergency for the Florida Building Code.
