Additional Information for Internet Course

Pursuant to Rule Chapter 61G6-9.005, Florida Administrative Code

- a) Course is interactive requiring student to navigate course material from start to finish. Links to pop-ups, videos, screen shots and sample reports are provided to reinforce student retention. Checkpoint exams at the end of each section confirm that student has completed the coursework. Bookmarks and pop-up help will facilitate ease of use.**
- b) Course provider will be able to monitor student enrollment, participation and course completion online at all times. A built-in time tracking system is included to ensure that students spend the required amount of time on coursework and included exams will ensure that content is understood.**
- c) Course content is monitored to ensure that stated course hours are consistent with the actual hours required to complete the course. New content is added on a regular basis to keep courses up to date and relevant.**
- d) Student may at any time request help via e-mail and receive a response within 4 hours on weekdays and within 12 hours during nights and weekends. Student may also call for help during normal business hours. Qualified instructor(s) will be available to answer questions during these times.**
- e) All students are required to electronically confirm an affidavit that is included on each course to ensure that they have personally completed each module of instruction.**

Login/Security
