HORIZONS BY MARRIOTT

Issue: Vertical accessibility to elevated play areas in a water park.

Analysis: The applicant is requesting a waiver to permit removal of two exterior lifts in a water park. According to the applicant, the lifts cost approximately \$58,000 and must be replaced at five year intervals because of conditions that cause them to deteriorate. As an alternative, the applicant would like to install one deck mounted water cannon immediately adjacent to the two elevated towers that would allow all guests to fire the cannon at the targets. Installation of the cannons would cost approximately \$20,000.

Project Progress:

The project is in plan review.

Items to be Waived:

Vertical accessibility to all levels, as required by Section 553.509, Florida Statutes.

- 553.509 Vertical a ccessibility. Nothing in Sections 553.501-553.513 or the guidelines shall be construed to relieve the owner of any building, structure or facility governed by those sections from the duty to provide vertical accessibility to all levels above and below the occupiable grade level regardless of whether the guidelines require an elevator to be installed in such building, structure or facility, except for:
 - (1) Elevator pits, elevator penthouses, mechanical rooms, piping or equipment catwalks and automobile lubrication and maintenance pits and platforms;
 - (2) Unoccupiable spaces, such as rooms, enclosed spaces and storage spaces that are not designed for human occupancy, for public accommodations or for work areas; and
 - (3) Occupiable spaces and rooms that are not open to the public and that house no more than five persons, including, but not limited to equipment control rooms and projection booths.

Waiver Criteria: There is no specific guidance for a waiver of this requirement in the code. The Commission's current rule, authorized in Section 553.512, Florida Statutes, provides criteria for granting waivers and allows consideration of unnecessary or extreme hardship to the applicant if the specific requirements were imposed.

Thank you for returning my phone call and providing the useful information. I've enclosed our application for waiver for your review.

As we discussed, our water park has two ADA elevators, (see photos) attached to identical towers each housing five water cannons that our guest shoot at targets. During the past six and a half years, we have never had a call for their use. They are rusting and need to be replaced at a cost of about \$58,000.

We believe it would be a better expense for us to be allowed to remove the elevators and install deck mounted cannons that could be use by all guest, handicapped or not.
