Section 23(4): Provides for an indefinite extension of an exception to the requirements that mechanical equipment comply with the wind design requirements of the FBC.

Mr. Madani provided background information on section 23(4) with staff proposal.

Discussion was held regarding the language and placement for this section among the TAC members.

Public comments were heard and discussed.

Mr. Schock entered a motion to accept staff proposal with exception added to 1620.6 and not delete but add to exception stating legislative language. Mr. Compton seconded the motion.
