ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE OLD BREWSTER HOSPITAL AΤ 915 WEST MONROE STREET, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, AS Α LANDMARK; DIRECTING THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER THE LANDMARK DESIGNATION ON THE ZONING ATLAS; DIRECTING THE COUNCIL SECRETARY TO NOTIFY EACH APPLICANT, THE PROPERTY OWNER AND THE PROPERTY APPRAISER OF THE LANDMARK DESIGNATION AND TO CAUSE SAID DESIGNATION TO BE RECORDED IN THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

promulgated Chapter 307, Ordinance Code, to facilitate the designation of landmarks and landmark sites, where appropriate; and WHEREAS, property owners within 350 feet of the boundaries of the property located at 915 West Monroe Street have been notified of the intent to designate the Old Brewster Hospital (the ASubject

Property≅), situated on the north side of West Monroe Street

between North Madison Street and North Davis Street in the LaVilla

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville City Council (the ACouncil≅)

section immediately west of Downtown Jacksonville, as a landmark; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 307, Ordinance Code, the Council has considered the issue of designating the Subject Property as a landmark, taking into consideration its importance and historical value, as more fully set forth in the Designation Application and Report of the Planning and Development Department, a copy of which is on file in the Council Secretary=s Office as Exhibit $AA\cong$ to this legislation, and incorporated by reference herein (the AReport \cong); and

WHEREAS, public hearings have been held by the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission, the Council and its committees regarding the issue of designating the Subject Property as a landmark; and

WHEREAS, by enacting this ordinance, the Council is exercising its power and authority to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jacksonville; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Designation of Landmark and Landmark Site.

Pursuant to Chapter 307, Ordinance Code, the Council hereby designates the Subject Property as a landmark.

Section 2. Satisfaction of Requisite Criteria. The Council hereby finds that the Subject Property satisfies at least four (4) of the requisite criteria set forth in Chapter 307, Ordinance Code, as more fully set forth in Exhibit $AA\cong$, attached hereto and made a

part hereof by this reference. 1 2 3 4 Section 3. Landmark Designation on Zoning Atlas. The Council 5 hereby directs the Zoning Administrator to designate the Subject Property as a landmark on the Zoning Atlas. 6 7 Section 4. Notice of Landmark Designation. The Council hereby directs the Council Secretary to notify each applicant, the 8 9 property owner and the Property Appraiser of the designation of the 10 Subject Property as a landmark. 11 Section 5. Recording of Landmark Designation. The Council 12 hereby directs the Council Secretary to record this ordinance in 13 the public records for Duval County, Florida. 14 Section 6. Effective Date.
