Analysis: The applicant is requesting a waiver from providing vertical accessibility to all rows of seats in an existing 8 theater movie complex. Four of the theaters are being modified from having sloped floors to stadium style seating. Each of the four theaters will have 195 seats and the 5 required accessible seating locations with companion seats have been provided. The project will cost \$400,000 and to make each row accessible via platform lift would cost \$13,718 per lift or a total of \$466,412.

Vertical accessibility to all rows of seats, as required by Section 553.509, Florida Statutes.

- 553.509 Vertical accessibility. Nothing in Sections 553.501-553.513 or the guidelines shall be construed to relieve the owner of any building, structure or facility governed by those sections from the duty to provide vertical accessibility to all levels above and below the occupiable grade level regardless of whether the guidelines require an elevator to be installed in such building, structure or facility, except for:
 - (1) Elevator pits, elevator penthouses, mechanical rooms, piping or equipment catwalks and automobile lubrication and maintenance pits and platforms;
 - (2) Unoccupiable spaces, such as rooms, enclosed spaces and storage spaces that are not designed for human occupancy, for public accommodations or for work areas; and
 - (3) Occupiable spaces and rooms that are not open to the public and that house no more than five persons, including, but not limited to equipment control rooms and projection booths.

Waiver Criteria: There is no specific guidance for a waiver of this requirement in the code. The Commission's current rule, authorized in Section 553.512, Florida Statutes, provides criteria for granting waivers and allows consideration of unnecessary or extreme hardship to the applicant if the specific requirements were imposed.

Substantial financial cost will be incurred by the Owner if the Waiver is denied.

The Ridge Cinema is an 8-screen, sloped seating movie theatre. The renovations will convert four (4) studios to stadium seating. Stadium seating is the industry standard and allows for unobstructed patron viewing of movies. Stadium seating is the issue for consideration of the accessibility waiver.

Each of the four (4) renovated studios is comprised of tiered platforms that are mostly 12" and some at 6" height difference from tier to tier. Wheelchair accessible seating locations are designed in accessible viewing locations in each auditorium, with companion seating. To design this theatre to provide wheelchair accessibility to every row of stadium seating will cause extreme hardship to the Owner as follow:

A. (36) chair lifts would be required to access every row of the renovated stadium seating:

B. To design the physical space required for each lift, and access on each side of the lift, we have calculated that approximately 34 square feet additional per lift is required which will reduce the total seat count. An average of 4.5 seats would be lost for each lift required.

Based on preliminary expectations of revenue per seat of \$1,800, lost revenue for one (1) year would be: \$1,800 x 162 seats = \$291,600.00

C. Each row of seating itself, accessed by the lift, must have an accessible rout to the disabled seating location. Each disabled seating location must have minimum clear floor space for a 60" turning diameter or 36" for "T" shaped turn. This will result in a loss of several rows of seating to allow access to the disabled seating location. For each 3.3 lifts installed, we loose a row of seats.

36 lifts / 3.3 = 11 rows x 20 seats = 220 seats lost

Based on preliminary expectations of revenue per seat of \$1,800, lost revenue for one (1) year would be: \$1,800 x 220 seats = \$396,000.00






TITLE RIDGE CINEMA SHEET: STUDIO #4 SKETCH: DATE 6-26-09 0906073




