# Code Sections on which Declaratory Statement is sought:

2010 Florida Building Code, portion of chapter 3 section 303.1, Assembly group A, exception (1) and Florida Building Code Plumbing, portion of chapter 4, section 403.2 separate facilities, exception (3).

## Background:

Doral, Fl 33166

We currently have a project in the City of Doral located on 8726 NW 26 St Doral fl. The building is an existing fourteen units warehouse building. The building is type III-A sprinkled with a total 58,503 SQ.FT. The unit is 1,711 SQ.FT.

The project is a Training area (Gym A-3 without spectators), used for Pilates, exercising. Etc.

We request a declaratory statement pertaining to Florida Building Code Building 2010, section 303 and Florida Building Code Plumbing 2010, section 403.2.

#### Reference:

Florida Building Code Building 2010

**SECTION 303 ASSEMBLY GROUP A** 

303.1 Assembly Group A. Assembly Group A occupancy includes, among others, the use of a building or structure, or a portion thereof, for the gathering of persons for the purposes such as civic, social or religious functions: recreation, food or drink consumption or awaiting transportation."

**Exceptions:** 

1. A building or tenant space used for assembly purposes with an occupant load of less than 50 persons shall be classified as a Group B occupancy.

**A-3** Assembly uses intended for worship, recreation or amusement and other Assembly uses not classified elsewhere in group A including, but not limited to:

Gymnasiums (without spectators)

## Florida Building Code Plumbing 2010

**403.2 Separate facilities.** Where plumbing fixtures are required, separate facilities shall be provided for each sex.

## **Exceptions:**

3. Separate facilities shall not be required in business and mercantile occupancies with a total floor area of 3,000 square feet (279m2) or less.

## Question:

When classifying an Assembly use as a Business according to Florida Building Code Building 2010 section 303.1 exception 1. Does section 403.2 Separate facilities, exception (3) also apply.
