Joe Belcher, FHBA, Masonry Association of FL, Florida Concrete and Associated Products Association, Aluminum Association of Florida and the International Hurricane Protection Association stated they supported this action.

Mike Silvers requested clarification as the prior overlapping code modification was not discussed.

Mr. Madani explained that there was only two parts in this modification thus the reason this was being discussed.

Mr. Rodriguez entered a motion to recommend based on criteria A, B, C and F. Mr. Zehnal seconded the motion. The motion passed with a vote of 6 in favor and one against.

Reconsideration S56-16:

Mike Silvers, FRSA, stated this was not listed as overlapping and he provided information that he felt this should be recommended under criteria F.

Eric Stafford, IBHS, provided additional information and stated this should be brought up in the second phase but is not opposed.
