WHEREAS, this resolution serves to correct a Scribner's error in the original resolution, dated May 19, 2010, and

WHEREAS, the Surf Club is an excellent example of the Mediterranean Revival Style (Spanish Style) architecture in the City of Surfside, built in 1930; and

WHEREAS, the correct legal description of the property, as designated, is as follows: All of lots 1 to 9, and S. 210.18' of Lot A, Block 1, Altos Del Mar No. 4 subdivision as recorded in Plat Book 10 at Page 63 of the public records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Surf Club was designed by Architect Russell T. Pancoast, a prominent architect in South Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Surf Club has contributed to the social history of the community of Surfside; and

WHEREAS, the Surf Club has influenced the development of the Town of Surfside; and

WHEREAS, members and guests of the Surf Club have made significant contribuitions to the history of this community, the country and the world and have included the Duke and Duchess of Windsor, Winston Churchill, Douglas Fairbanks Jr., General Douglas McArthur, Lily Pons, Tony Bennett and more recently Senator and Mrs. Robert Dole; and

WHEREAS, the interior spaces of the Surf Club present important architectural and design features such as original floors, ceilings, arches, etc., that enhance the historic character of the property and shall be preserved and are included in this designation
