THURSDAY, JUNE 6, 2019

MEETING SUMMARY AND OVERVIEW

At the Thursday, June 6, 2019 teleconference meeting the POC considered regular procedural issues including product approval and entities statistics reports; a status report on conditional approvals from the April 16, 2019 Commission meeting, indicating that all of the applications are now resolved and approved; review and approval of product and entity applications; a review of DBPR approved product approval applications. Specific actions included: recommending the Commission take action on product and entity applications as recommended by the POC and reflected in DBPR staff's product and entity approval reports; and, recommending that the Commission decline the Petition for DS 2019-021 by Jason Malouf of Window and Door Design Center, since a declaratory statement is not the appropriate means for determining the conduct of another person.

AGENDA ITEM OUTCOMES

A. 4. AGENDA REVIEW

The POC voted unanimously, 4 - 0 in favor, to approve the agenda for the June 6, 2019 meeting as posted/presented. Following are the key agenda items approved for consideration:

B. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THE APRIL 4, 2019 MINUTES AND FACILITATOR'S SUMMARY REPORT

MOTION—The POC voted unanimously, 5-0 in favor, to approve the April 4, 2019 meeting minutes and Facilitator's Summary Report as posted/presented.

Amendments:

C. 1. PRODUCT APPROVAL AND ENTITIES STATISTICS REPORT

Mo Madani reviewed the product and entities statistics reports with participants and answered members' questions. Mo reported that the total number of product approval applications approved to the 2017 Code is 5,424 (6,149 total in the System), the total number of products approved to the 2017 Code is 22,130 (25,318 total in the System), and the total number of entities approved to the 2017 Code is 126 (408 total in the System). The reports are linked to the Product Approval POC's agenda.

C. 2. REPORT ON CONDITIONAL APPROVALS FROM THE APRIL 16, 2019 FBC MEETING

Jeff Blair noted that all of the relevant conditions were met for each of the conditional approvals reported at the April 16, 2019 Commission meeting, and are now approved.

C.3. Consideration of DS 2019-021 by Jason Malouf of Window and Door Design Center

Jason Malouf of Window and Door Design Center submitted a petition for a declaratory statement for review by the Product Approval POC. All of the relevant documentation is linked to the June 6, 2019 Product Approval POC agenda found on-line (BCIS). Justin Vogel, provided staff's analysis on the Petition. The petitioner was not available to provide additional input, and subsequently following questions and answers and an opportunity for public comment, the POC took the following action:

POC Actions:

MOTION—The POC voted unanimously, 5 - 0 in favor, to recommend the Commission approve the POC's recommendation on the Petition: to decline the Petition, since a declaratory statement is not the appropriate means for determining the conduct of another person.

Staff Analysis:

Petitioner alleges that they "have recently become aware of practices by certain individuals which do not seem to conform to Rule 61G20-3.009(4) in over 1000+ instances," and in the petition list certain entities and approved products that they find potentially problematic.

Rule 28-105.001, Florida Administrative Code, specifies that "[a] declaratory statement is not the appropriate means for determining the conduct of another person." Furthermore, "a petition for a declaratory statement which seeks approval or disapproval of conduct which has already occurred is properly denied." *See Novick v. Dep't of Health*, 816 So. 2d 1237, 1240 (Fla 5th DCA 2002) (citing Chiles v. Dep't of State, Div. of Elections, 711 So 2d 151 (Fla. 1st DCA 1998).

Since the Petitioner's questions pertain to the past conduct of other individuals, their petition should be declined, since a declaratory statement is not the appropriate mechanism through which to address their concerns.

D. 1. PRODUCT AND ENTITY APPLICATIONS CONSENT AGENDA

Jeff Blair presented the consent agenda for entities by asking if any participants wished to have any entity applications pulled from the consent agenda for individual consideration. There were no entity applications pulled for individual consideration. Jeff Blair presented the consent agenda for approval of products by asking if any participants' wished to have any applications pulled from the consent agenda for individual consideration. There were no product approval applications pulled for individual consideration.

POC Actions:

MOTION—The POC voted unanimously, 5 - 0 in favor, to recommend the Commission approve the consent agenda of product approval entities (19) recommended for approval as posted. **MOTION**—The POC voted unanimously, 5 - 0 in favor, to recommend the Commission approve the consent agenda of products (172) recommended for approval to the 2017 Code as presented/posted.

PRODUCT APPROVAL APPLICATIONS PULLED FROM THE CONSENT AGENDA FOR INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION

None.

D. 2. PRODUCT APPROVAL APPLICATIONS WITH DISCUSSION OR COMMENTS

Jeff Blair presented the products with discussion and public comment. Following are the POC's recommendations on the (1) product approval application submitted for approval to the 2017 Code with public comment:

• The POC recommends the Commission conditionally approve product FL 29457 based on the conditions requested by the applicant and recommended by DBPR staff (5 - 0) in favor).

D. 3. DBPR APPLICATIONS

Jeff Blair noted that there were a total of 112 DBPR applications including 5 applications with comments submitted for approval to the 2017 Code. Staff noted that the applications with comments have been resolved to staff's satisfaction (either the application was revised or no change was needed) and no further action was required for approval of the products. The balance of the DBPR applications for the cycle were approved, and no further action was required of the POC. All of the recommendations for the DBPR applications are linked to the June 6, 2019 Product Approval POC agenda posted on the BCIS.
