#### MUVICO BOYNTON BEACH 16

Issue: Vertical accessibility to all rows of stadium seating in a movie theater.

Analysis: The applicant is requesting a waiver from providing vertical accessibility to all rows of stadium seats in a new, \$7,155,000 16 theater movie complex. The project will consist of theaters ranging from an occupancy of 135 to o416 seats. In the smallest theaters, accessible seats are placed on the first tier of seats, not the immediate front of the theaters and in the larger theaters, dispersed in more than one area. According to the applicant, requiring all rows of seats to be accessible would constitute an unnecessary, unreasonable and extreme hardship. No cost estimates were submitted.

#### **Project Progress:**

The project is in plan review.

#### Items to be Waived:

Vertical accessibility to all rows of seats, as required by Section 553.509, Florida Statutes.

- 553.509 Vertical a ccessibility. Nothing in Sections 553.501-553.513 or the guidelines shall be construed to relieve the owner of any building, structure or facility governed by those sections from the duty to provide vertical accessibility to all levels above and below the occupiable grade level regardless of whether the guidelines require an elevator to be installed in such building, structure or facility, except for:
  - Elevator pits, elevator penthouses, mechanical rooms, piping or equipment catwalks and automobile lubrication and maintenance pits and platforms;
  - (2) Unoccupiable spaces, such as rooms, enclosed spaces and storage spaces that are not designed for human occupancy, for public accommodations or for work areas; and
  - (3) Occupiable spaces and rooms that are not open to the public and that house no more than five persons, including, but not limited to equipment control rooms and projection booths.

Waiver Criteria: There is no specific guidance for a waiver of this requirement in the code. The Commission's current rule, authorized in Section 553.512, Florida Statutes, provides criteria for granting waivers and allows consideration of unnecessary or extreme hardship to the applicant if the specific requirements were imposed.

The issue of the requirement for vertical accessibility to all levels, as mandated by the Florida State Statutes, section 553.509 VERTICAL ACCESSIBILITY. This section states that -Nothing in sections 553.501 - 553.513 or the guidelines shall be construed to relieve the owner of any building, structure, or facility governed by those sections from the duty to provide vertical accessibility to all levels above and below the habitable grade level, regardless of whether the guidelines require an elevator to be installed in such building, structure, or facility. However; we do not believe that this type of construction (stadium style seating in a movie theater) was contemplated by the legislation in the drafting and implementation of the law for vertical accessibility and that the statute itself would impose a hardship on the applicant that is unique to the situation and more specifically its use nor that they meant that every level of stadium style seating shall be made accessible. The concept of stadium type seating is the current standard that the movie theater industry is using for all new theater design. The industry, around the country, have been using section 4.33.3 Placement Of Wheelchair Locations for proceeding with their designs. This section states that - Wheelchair areas shall be an integral part of any fixed seating plan and shall be provided so as to provide people with physical disabilities a choice of admission prices and lines of sight comparable to those for members of the general public. They shall adjoin an accessible route that also serves as a means of egress in case of emergency. At least one companion fixed seat shall be provided next to each wheelchair seating area. When the seating capacity exceeds 300, wheelchair spaces shall be provided in more than one location. Readily removable seats may be installed in wheelchair spaces when the spaces are not required to accommodate wheelchair users. EXCEPTION: Accessible viewing positions may be clustered for bleachers, balconies, and other areas having sight lines that require slopes of greater than 5 percent. Equivalent accessible viewing positions may be located on levels having accessible egress. Muvico has listened to (The Theater Design Charette) and has adjutted their designs to work towards accomplishing the requests/desires of the Council and the Commission. The concern of the industry is to strike a balance between the desires of the Council and the Commission and the construction process. It is financial impracticable to provide vertical accessibility to EACH level of stadium style seating in a movie theater. This is due to the costs that would be required by the accessible design requirements of the FACBC and the ADA (e.g.: They [the seating] shall adjoin an accessible route that also serves as a means of egress in case of emergency). You can not do this for each level and build stadium style seating that would provide a cost effective and usable solution to meet all of the Florida specific requirements relating to this issue. With this in mind Muvico has worked towards providing the accessible seating in the first row of the start of the stadium seating (at the crossover aisle); with this row actually being row three or four back from the actual first row of the theater seating. It




