## **Meeting Objectives:**

- To discuss the inclusion by modification a Cross reference to Chapter 27, similar to the FBC 2001 Code. This cross reference would be inclusive to the 2004 Building and the Residential Code.
- Recommendation by modification to include the FBC, Building, 2005 NEC 70 & NEC 70A Residential to the FBC.
- Discuss securing lightning protective devices or other devices that structurally attached as a system: Note the issue is on fastening, connecting and or attached. Note this issue will be sent to the Structural TAC for further discussion and direction to the Electrical TAC.

## **Committee Report:**

- 1. The meeting was called to order. The roll call was taken. Nine (9) committee members were present and two were absent. A quorum was achieved. The agenda for October 10, 2005 was reviewed, and approved as amended.
- 2. To consider modification to include a cross reference to 2004 FBC, Chapter 27 Building and Chapter 33 Residential, and related reference chapters of the Code.
- 3. To consider modification to include the NEC 70 and NEC 70A to the Code as minimum for the Electrical requirements for the State of Florida.
- 4. Discuss structurally attached systems to the roof, lightning and other mechanically fastened devices; this issue will be discussed by the Structural TAC to give direction back to the Electrical TAC.
