# Roof Tile Installation Recommendations Based on the FRSA/TRI Concrete and Clay Tile Installation Manual

(App-TileInstallation-4.0)

### Course Description (See attached outline):

The course will begin with a review of the Fourth Edition FRSA/TRI Concrete and Clay Tile Installation Manual and how to use the manual as a guide for installing systems one, two, three and four A&B.

**System 1** – Unsealed or sealed underlayment system using preformed metal flashings with edge returns. Tiles are applied over the underlayment with mechanical fasteners to the deck with or without horizontal battens.

**System 2** -Sealed underlayment system using standard metal flashing. Tiles are applied with mechanical fasteners direct to waterproofed deck or on counter battens.

**System 3** - Sealed underlayment system using standard metal flashings. Tiles are applied with mortar direct to waterproofed deck.

**System 4A** - Unsealed or sealed underlayment system using preformed metal flashings with edge returns. Tiles are applied over the underlayment with adhesive to the deck with or without horizontal battens.

**System 4B**- Sealed underlayment system using standard metal flashings. Tiles are applied with adhesive direct to waterproofed deck.
