Note: Any individual or entity involved with the construction activity is required to comply with the Florida Building Code. The number of individuals or entities impacted by the proposed update to the FBC and the direct and indirect costs are indeterminate. The number and the cost are primarily dependent upon the decision by consumers of construction services and products whether to proceed with projects using specific design criteria selected from several performance and prescriptive options of the FBC. However, with exception of the minimal engineering cost impact of the proposed update to the wood design values for the Southern Pine, 2x4s, No.2, the agency does not foresee that this rule will have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200.000. In fact, majority of the proposed changes will improve enforcement and implementation of the code, thus reducing cost of compliance to building construction.
