FLORIDA BUILDING COMMISSION

- To determine the statutory authority for requiring special inspections of alterations and renovations of threshold buildings.
- To recommend to the Structural TAC and Florida Building Commission actions appropriate to implementation of the Workgroup's conclusions.
- To coordinate with representatives of industry and the Florida Board of Professional Engineers.

The Workgroup will deliver their consensus recommendations to the Florida Building Commission's Structural TAC. The Structural TAC will deliver final recommendations to the Florida Building Commission for the Commission's consideration.

Issues:

Authorized representative qualifications;

Scope of issues bound by Chapter 553 Florida Statutes relevant authorities; and At what point are special inspections required for alterations of existing buildings.

DISCUSSION OF ISSUES/SCOPING DISCUSSION

The Workgroup discussed issues regarding special inspections of the alterations and renovations of threshold buildings and decided that absent a representative from the Florida Board of Professional Engineers no recommendations should be developed. Following questions and answers, public comment, and discussion the Workgroup took the following action:

Workgroup Action:

Motion—The Threshold Building Renovation Workgroup voted unanimously, 5 - 0 in favor, to recommend the Florida Building Commission send a letter to the Florida Board of Professional Engineers (FBPE) requesting written clarification by providing a more narrowly defined scope of the specific issues they would like the Commission to address regarding special inspections of the alterations and renovations of threshold buildings, and to provide the FBPE with a copy of the Commission's predecessor body, the Florida Board of Building Codes and Standards', previous rule regarding requirements for special inspections of threshold buildings, and requirements for inspectors authorized representatives.

GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT

Members of the public were invited to provide the Committee with comments. There were no general public comments provided. Members of the public were provided opportunities spoke on each of the substantive discussion issues before the Committee.

NEXT STEPS

The Workgroup will meet once they receive clarification from the Florida Board of Professional Engineers and a commitment to attend the next meeting.
