MEETING SUMMARY AND OVERVIEW

At the October 17, 2017 Teleconference Commission meeting the Commission voted unanimously: to approve the Energy Code Compliance Software for the 6th Edition (2017) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation, specifically EnergyGauge USA 6.0 for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements; and, to conditionally approve the Energy Code Compliance Software for the 6th Edition (2017) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation, specifically Right-Suite Universal 2017 (using Right-Energy Florida 2017) for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements for new construction, single-family houses, conditioned on the vendor correcting the program consistent with DBPR staff's comments.

Approval of Energy Code Compliance Software for the 6^{th} Edition (2017) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation

Vice-Chair Schock remarked that periodically the Commission is requested to consider approval of Energy Code Compliance Software for specific editions of the Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation.

At the October 17, 2017 meeting the Commission was asked to consider approving Energy Code Compliance Software for the 6th Edition (2017) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation, specifically EnergyGauge USA 6.0 for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements.

In addition, the Commission was asked to consider approving Energy Code Compliance Software for the 6th Edition (2017) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation, specifically Right-Suite Universal 2017 (using Right-Energy Florida 2017) for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements for new construction, single-family houses.

The Energy TAC reviewed the EnergyGauge USA 6.0 for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements and is recommending approval. In addition, the TAC reviewed Right-Suite Universal 2017 (using Right-Energy Florida 2017) for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements for new construction, single-family houses and is recommending approval.

Commissioner Schock reported that the Energy TAC met on October 17, 2017 to review the two requests for approving Energy Code Compliance Software for the 6th Edition (2017) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation, and recommended the Commission approve the EnergyGauge USA 6.0 software, and to conditionally approve the Right-Suite Universal 2017 software.

Following an opportunity for questions and answers, public comment and discussion, the Commission took the following action:

Commission Actions:

MOTION—The Commission voted unanimously, 18 - 0 in favor, to approve the Energy Code Compliance Software for the 6^{th} Edition (2017) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation, specifically EnergyGauge USA 6.0 for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements.

MOTION—The Commission voted unanimously, 18-0 in favor, to conditionally approve the Energy Code Compliance Software for the 6^{th} Edition (2017) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation, specifically Right-Suite Universal 2017 (using Right-Energy Florida 2017) for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements for new construction, single-family houses, conditioned on the vendor correcting the program consistent with DBPR staff's comments.

Members of the public were offered an opportunity to provide comment during each of the Commission's substantive discussion agenda items. In addition, Vice-Chair Schock invited members of the public to address the Commission on any issues under the Commission's purview.
