This document shall serve to state that the product(s) listed herein successfully tested to the ASTM E 1996-05 test method also meet testing requirements set forth by ASTM E 1996-02 and ASTM E 1996-06 up to Wind Zone 3.

The revision from ASTM E 1996-05 to ASTM E 1996-05b, as well as all subsequent versions, introduces additional Wind Zone 4 impact requirements that differ from previous versions: "5.3.3.6 In Wind Zone 4, impact the integral mullion and other intermediate members such as the meeting rail, check rail, or meeting stile mid-span..."

Since the scope of this application allows for the product(s) listed herein to be installed <u>only</u> in regions up to Wind Zone 3. All other methods, criteria, and aspects of the testing requirements between ASTM E 1996-05 and ASTM E 1996-02 are to be considered equivalent.
