1.) Course Number 1124.0....

Course: Advanced FBC: 7th Edition (2020) – Five Walls of the FBC – A Guide to Fire Resistance &

Fire Protection

This is a 2-hour instructor led course that provides a working knowledge of the five walls of the FBC. Attendees will learn the prescriptive differences between wall ratings (fire-resistance), opening protective ratings (fire protection), and how each perform in passive redundant systems. Attendees will understand the use of each wall, its opening protectives and applications within the framework of code compliance. Also, test criteria for fire resistance and opening protection will be illustrated and explained.

As a result of an administrative review of this course, **I found no issues and recommend approval.**

2.) Course Number 1125.0...

Course: Advanced Electrical 6th Edition

This is a 1-hour online course that introduces the State of Florida's Advanced Electrical Codes (6th Edition). Participants in the class will recognize the importance of Building Code Regulations. They will recall the types of codes that apply and they will review the details of Chapter 42 of the Florida Electrical Codes.

After an administrative review of this course, it was found that...

a. A reference to the 7th Edition of the building code should be removed from the "Course Description" on page two

As a result, I recommend denial of this course because it does not meet the full requirements of Rule 61G20-6.002. However, the ED POC could motion to instead conditionally approve this course, subject to removing the reference to the 7th Edition of the building code from the "Course Description" on page two.
