### **Approval of the Minutes from February 6, 2017**

Mr. Lavrich entered a motion to approve the minutes from the February 6, 2017 meeting. Mr. Compton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 11 to 0.

# To review and accept interim draft report for the research project titled "Corrosion of Roofing Fasteners":

Mr. Madani provided a short summary of the report for the TACs.

Kurt Gurley, UF presented phase four of this project. He provided detail on the additional tile fastener testing and ratings of corrosion and explanation of the testing results to date.

#### **TAC comments:**

Mr. Makar inquired about the NOA and availability of the identification of the products used in testing.

Mr. Gurley stated they might be able to produce those records.

Mr. Cone inquired about the testing with the tile fasteners and the comparison to the worse case results. In addition he stated he understood the testing would not identify any product titles or manufacturer. He stated by giving this information you are singling out manufacturers.
