This course is based on the Building Officials Association of Florida (BOAF) model chapter 1 of the Florida Building Code 8th Edition 2023 and covers requirements such as application of the code, Permit requirements, inspection requirements, plans requirements, certificate of occupancy requirements, stop work orders and more.

After an administrative review of this course, it was found that...

- a. The provider's name, address, phone number, and email should be added to the Certificate of Completion.
- b. The reference to the "7th Edition" should be changed to the "8th Edition" at the top of PowerPoint slides 12 & 13.

As a result, I recommend denial of this course because it does not meet the full requirements of Rule 61G20-6.002.
