5.) Review and discuss possible language changes to Rule 61G20-6.002

Discussion: The ED POC members had a discussion at the December 7, 2020 meeting suggesting that the FBC Education Program Rule (61G20-6.002) might need some updating regarding the current language. As a result of that discussion, Commissioner John listed a few opportunities as to where the ED POC might begin.

Chair Dean asked Thomas Campbell (DBPR Executive Director of Building Codes & Standards) to lead the current discussion. Mr. Campbell pointed out that the Building Commission is given the authority for creating and maintaining Rule 61G20-6.002 through 553.841, the Building Code Compliance and Mitigation Program, 2020 Florida Statutes. Mr. Campbell further referenced Paragraph 4, in Rule 61G20-6.002 as the primary point of reference for possible changes.

Mr. Campbell then mentioned the areas and/or language that could be scrutinized for possible changes, mostly based on Commissioner John's recommendations. Those possibilities included but are not limited to:

- 1. Deleting the term "Internet" and using instead "Online"
- 2. Defining what "Online" means (versus instructor led) because there are 4-5 versions of online courses as a result of new technology
- 3. Require a title page/slide for all presentations containing the same information
- 4. Requiring (in the BCIS) separate uploads for the course syllabus, course materials, course outline, course timeline, learning objectives, and method of course evaluation
- 5. Defining what "course evaluation" means. Does it mean to evaluate the course by the participants, or does it mean for the instructor to evaluate how well the participants did during the course?

After a brief discussion, Mr. Campbell asked for a motion from the ED POC members to open the rulemaking process regarding the discussed possible changes to the language of Rule 61G20-6.002. A motion was put forth by Commissioner John.

- -- Advertisement (must be approved in advance)
- -- Sign in sheets as acceptable for each licensing board
- -- Separate sign in sheets for licensees and non-licensed employees
- -- Non-licensed employee sign in sheets must include type of proof submitted
- -- *Copy of course evaluation for each attendee

*Failure to demonstrate that 75% or more of trainees were satisfied or highly satisfied with the course instructor will result in a 1% penalty for each 5% increment or portion thereof that the percentage of satisfied trainees fall below 75%.
