Mr. Schock welcomed everyone to the meeting of the Hurricane Research Advisory Committee.

Roll Call:

Mr. Blair performed roll call for the HRAC. A quorum was determined with 13 members present at roll call.

Agenda Approval:

Mr. Blair covered the agenda items for the meeting today.

Mr. Blair asked for a motion to approve the agenda for October 12, 2021 as posted if there were no changes.

Mr. Seijas entered a motion to approve the agenda as posted. Commissioner Compton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 14 to 0.

Approval of Meeting from September 13, 2021:

Mr. Plisich recommended amending the minutes for the September 13, 2021 meeting.

Mr. Seijas entered a motion to approve the minutes for September 13, 2021 meeting as amended. Mr. Belcher seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote 14 to 0.

Mr. Blair instructed the Committee about the process for commenting on the International Code Council's draft "Appendix C Existing Building Safety Inspection Guide."

Dominic Sims introduced Mike Pfeiffer, Senior Vice President of Technical Services who is responsible for the ICC's codes and standards development processes.

The HRAC discussed the scope of work for the International Code Council's draft Appendix C Existing Building Safety Inspection Guide.

Commissioner Swope entered a motion to discontinue the process providing comments on the scope of work Mr. Belcher seconded the motion.

The HRAC continued to discuss their concerns with the scope of work for the International Code Council's draft "Appendix C Existing Building Safety Inspection Guide."

Dr. Schedel stated that she would be abstaining from voting on recommendations regarding the International Code Council's draft "Appendix C Existing Building Safety Inspection Guide," since was retained by ICC to assist in development of part of the appendix and thus may have a financial interest in the matter."

Public Comment:

Dan Lavrich is in favor of the motion and stated his concern of using the term "recertification."

Mike Silvers, FRSA is in favor of the motion.

Rick Logan, AIA stated their comments were sent straight to staff.

Provide Comments on the International Code Council's Draft "Appendix C Existing Building Safety Inspection Guide." (cont.)

Laurance Dickie, licensed architect and contractor in the state of Florida, recommended the Florida Building Commission be the lead for this scope of work. He is not in agreement with the motion, but is in favor of advancing the draft, so it can be a published document.

The HRAC continued to discuss their concerns with the scope of work for the International Code Council's draft "Appendix C Existing Building Safety Inspection Guide."

Mr. Blair performed roll call for the HRAC. The motion failed by a vote of 10-4.

Provide Comments on the International Code Council's Draft "Appendix C Existing Building Safety Inspection Guide." (cont.)

Commissioner Shock entered a motion to recommend to the Commission that the scope of work be revised to develop a fundamental, basic, minimum inspection plan template for existing buildings by evaluating available documents, templates, programs, research, and data as a starting point, and with the flexibility to use data and research project results as they become available. The scope and purpose for the work will be further refined once Commission direction is received. Mr. Ascunce seconded the motion.

The HRAC continued to discuss their concerns with the scope of work for the International Code Council's draft "Appendix C Existing Building Safety Inspection Guide."

Eric Stafford became the alternate for Dr. Anne Cope.

The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 14-0 in favor.

Identification and Discussion of Next Steps:

Dominic Sims provided some feedback on the next steps on the International Code Council's draft "Appendix C Existing Building Safety Inspection Guide."
