61G20-2.002	Ch. 2011-222, Laws of Florida, amended ss. 553.73(7)(g), F.S. that requires three additional pieces of information to be collected from people who propose amendment to the Florida Building Code. The electronic code modification form, which is adopted by rule, needs to be amended to collect these additional pieces of information. Other improvements are also planned that will make the electronic process of requesting code modifications easier and more user-friendly. The amendment will not place any restriction on entry into a profession, affect on availability of services to public, affect job retention, restrict employment seekers, or impose burdensome costs.
