Dear Mr. Veksenfeld:

I am in receipt of your Petition for Declaratory Statement to the Florida Building Commission regarding the interpretation of Florida Building Code Chapter 101.4.2.3.1. Section 120.565, Florida Statutes, which governs declaratory statements by state agencies, states in pertinent part:

"The petition seeking a declaratory statement shall state with particularity the petitioner's set of circumstances and shall specify the statutory provision, rule, or order that the petitioner believes may apply to the set of circumstances."

§ 120.565(2), F.S.

While your Petitioner does identify the Code section of concern, it does not state with particularity the set of circumstances to which you believe that section of the Code applies. It is therefore legally insufficient and cannot provide the basis for the Commission to consider issuing a declaratory statement.

You may amend your Petition to include the statutorily required information. The "set of circumstances" and "particularity" requirements may be satisfied in your case by amending the Petition to identify, describe, and provide an address for the building in question.

Please note that your Petition will be dismissed if it not amended to conform to the requirements of law. Should you choose to submit an amended petition for declaratory statement, please send it to my attention at the address indicated below.
