Mr. Blair welcomed everyone to the teleconference/webinar meeting of the Code Administration TAC.

#### **Roll Call:**

Mr. Blair performed roll call for the Code Administration TAC. A quorum was determined with 6 members present at roll call.

#### **Agenda Approval:**

Mr. Boyer entered a motion to approve the agenda for today's meeting as posted. Mr. O'Connor seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 6 to 0.

#### Approval of Minutes from June 22, 2021:

Mr. Boyer entered a motion to approve the minutes from June 22, 2021 as posted. Mr. O'Connor seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 6 to 0.

To review and consider errata submitted pursuant to Section 553.73(8), Florida Statutes and to provide recommendation to the Commission regarding those errata that are needed to correct demonstrated errors in the  $7^{th}$  Edition (2020) Florida Building Code, as applicable:

#### CA-FBC-B-Ch.1-Errata #1:

Comments and changes were submitted by DBPR/FBC Commission Staff for the Consideration of the TAC.

Mr. Madani stated that the proposed change is being brought to ensure the Florida Building Code, 7<sup>th</sup> Edition, (2020), is consistent with statutory changes from HB 401 (2021).

Mr. Vogel noted that the proposed modification is not technically an errata, but rather a change required by recent legislative action, and stated that the Commission may promulgate the change under the same statutory authority utilized for the errata.
