The architect may be wrong in the premise, "asking for an FBC #" but this is the perception and the same is true with Builders, and Building Inspectors. The majority of them incorrectly believe FBC code approval numbers apply to all products as a basis for their product decision making and have done so for years. We have submitted our CCRR Report showing testing results to FBC codes to them but they do not accept that as sufficient. They just ask us for the FBC number and will not review, use, or approve our product otherwise

Petitioner respectfully seeks clarification whether railing systems fall under the scope of the FBC product approval program. We appreciate your consideration of this information and request for a Declaratory Statement
