## THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2017

### MEETING SUMMARY AND OVERVIEW

At the Thursday, November 30, 2017 teleconference meeting the POC considered regular procedural issues including product approval and entities statistics reports; a status report on conditional approvals from the August 2017 Commission meeting, all applications are now resolved and approved; review and approval of product and entity applications; and a review of DBPR approved product approval applications. Specific actions included: recommending the Commission take action on DS 2017-072 as recommended by the POC and reflected in the Facilitator's Summary Report; and, recommending the Commission take action on product and entity applications as recommended by the POC and reflected in DBPR staff's product and entity approval reports.

### **AGENDA ITEM OUTCOMES**

### A. 1. STATEMENT OF TELECONFERENCE PARTICIPATION PROCESS

### A. 4. AGENDA REVIEW

The POC voted unanimously, 6 - 0 in favor, to approve the agenda for the November 30, 2017 meeting as amended\*. Following are the key agenda items approved for consideration:

# B. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THE SEPTEMBER 28, 2017 MINUTES AND FACILITATOR'S SUMMARY REPORT

**MOTION**—The POC voted unanimously, 6-0 in favor, to approve the September 28, 2017 meeting minutes and Facilitator's Summary Reports as posted/presented.

Amendments:

### C. 1. PRODUCT APPROVAL AND ENTITIES STATISTICS REPORT

Zubeyde Binici reviewed the product and entities statistics reports with participants and answered members' questions. Zubeyde reported that the total number of product approval applications approved to the 2014 Code is 6,009 (6,597 total in the System), the total number of products approved to the 2014 Code is 25,526 (28,613 total in the System), and the total number of entities approved to the 2014 Code is 127 (404 total in the System). The total number of product approval applications approved to the 2017 Code is 1,166 (2,381 total in the System), the total number of products approved to the 2017 Code is 4,165 (9,555 total in the System), and the total number of

entities approved to the 2017 Code is 127 (404 total in the System). The reports are linked to the Product Approval POC's agenda.

### C. 2. REPORT ON CONDITIONAL APPROVALS FROM THE OCTOBER 10, 2017 MEETING

Commissioner Stone noted that with one exception (FL 22881) the conditions were met for all of the conditional approvals reported at the October 10, 2017 Commission meeting, and the products are now approved. It was noted that pursuant to the product manufacturer's e-mail communication, FL 22881 has been abandoned by the product manufacturer due to moving the products under other approvals. Staff noted that this application will be archived, and no further action is needed on the application.

### C. 3. DS 2017-072 BY CHRIS BIRCHFIELD OF GLOBAL FIREPROOF SOLUTIONS, INC.

Global Fireproof Solutions, Inc. submitted a petition for a declaratory statement for review by the Product Approval POC. All of the relevant documentation is linked to the November 30, 2017 Product Approval POC agenda found on-line.

The Petitioner seeks a Declaratory Statement on whether fire retardant products as listed in the Petition fall outside the scope of Rule 61G20-3.

The petitioner was offered an opportunity to provide input but was not on the call, and subsequently Mo Madani reviewed the petition and provided staff's analysis as follows:

Question 1: Do the products listed above fall within the scope of Rule 61G20-3, F.A.C.?

Answer: No, the products in question are not elements of the building envelope or structural frame and, therefore, fall outside of the scope of the state product approval pursuant to Rule 61G20-3, F.A.C. However, the products in question are subject to review and approval at the local level.

Following the opportunity provided for questions and answers, public comment and POC discussion, the POC took the following action:

### POC Actions:

**MOTION**—The POC voted unanimously, 6-0 in favor, to recommend that the Commission approve the Product Approval POC's recommendation on the Petition (to approve staff's analysis as presented for Q 1).

### D. 1. PRODUCT AND ENTITY APPLICATIONS CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Stone presented the consent agenda for entities by asking if any participants wished to have any entity applications pulled from the consent agenda for individual consideration. There were no entity applications pulled for individual consideration. Commissioner Stone presented the consent agenda for approval of products by asking if any participants' wished to have any applications pulled from the consent agenda for individual consideration. There were no product approval applications pulled for individual consideration.

### POC Actions:

**MOTION**—The POC voted unanimously, 6 - 0 in favor, to recommend the Commission approve the consent agenda of product approval entities (9) recommended for approval as posted.

**MOTION**—The POC voted unanimously, 6 - 0 in favor, to recommend the Commission approve the consent agenda of products (10) recommended for approval to the 2014 Code as presented/posted.

**MOTION**—The POC voted unanimously, 6 - 0 in favor, to recommend the Commission approve the consent agenda of products (939) recommended for approval to the 2017 Code as presented/posted.

# PRODUCT APPROVAL APPLICATIONS PULLED FROM THE CONSENT AGENDA FOR INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION

None were pulled.

### D. 2. PRODUCT APPROVAL APPLICATIONS WITH DISCUSSION OR COMMENTS

Jeff Blair presented the products with discussion and public comment. Following are the POC's recommendations on the (0) product approval applications submitted for approval to the 2014 Code with public comment:

There were no comments on product approval applications submitted for approval to the 2014 Code.

Jeff Blair presented the products with discussion and public comment. Following are the POC's recommendations on the (5) product approval applications submitted for approval to the 2017 Code with public comment:

- The POC recommends the Commission conditionally approve product FL 16294 R-3 based on the conditions requested by the applicant and recommended by DBPR staff (6-0) in favor).
- The POC recommends the Commission conditionally approve product FL 17010 R-3 based on the conditions requested by the applicant and recommended by DBPR staff (6 0) in favor).
- The POC recommends the Commission conditionally approve product FL 19266 R-1 based on the conditions requested by the applicant and recommended by DBPR staff (6 0) in favor).
- The POC recommends the Commission conditionally approve product FL 20378 R-1 based on the conditions requested by the applicant and recommended by DBPR staff (6-0 in favor).
- The POC recommends the Commission conditionally approve product FL 21146 R-2 based on the conditions requested by the applicant and recommended by DBPR staff (6-0) in favor).

Product FL 13732 R-3 was added to the agenda since it was left off of the consent agenda for approval due to an administrative oversight:

The POC recommends the Commission approve product FL 13732 R-3 (6 - 0 in favor).

### D. 3. DBPR APPLICATIONS

Commissioner Stone noted that there were no applications with comments submitted for approval to the 2014 Code, and five applications with comments submitted for approval to the 2017 Code. Staff noted that the applications with comments have been resolved to staff's satisfaction (either the application was revised or no change was needed) and no further action was required for approval of the products. The balance of the DBPR applications for the cycle were approved, and no further action was required of the POC. All of the recommendations for the DBPR applications are linked to the November 30, 2017 Product Approval POC agenda posted on the BCIS.

### E. 1. Public Comment

Commissioner Stone invited members of the public to address the Product Approval POC on any issues under the POC's purview.

- 2.) The POC recommends the Commission take action on declaratory statement DS 2017-072 by Chris Birchfield of Global Fireproof Solutions, Inc. as recommended by the POC.

The POC will meet February 1, 2018 to provide recommendations to the Commission on Product Approval System relevant issues for the February 13, 2017 Commission meeting.
