- contractors, or building code administrators or inspectors
- -- Home inspectors, mold remediators

--- Must include license number for all categories above -- Employees in design and construction industries, requires this documentation: --- Letter from their design/construction licensed employer --- Copy of certificate of workers' compensation insurance or exemption Eligible course topics: -- Florida Building Code -- Florida Fire Prevention Code -- Construction plan and permitting requirements -- Construction liens -- Hurricane mitigation For "minimum 1 hour" program, course requirements: -- At least 50% must be codes For 7-hour program, course requirements: -- At least three (3) hours codes -- At least two (2) hours advanced codes For any program, course requirements: -- Mitigation training for home inspectors must include proctored exam and comply with section 627.711(2), F.S. -- *Course evaluations are REQUIRED that cover the following: --- Satisfaction with instructor --- Satisfaction with course materials --- Satisfaction with conduct of the training --- Ask whether "highly satisfied" "satisfied" "not satisfied" for each above Must enter into an agreement before submitting for grant funds, must verify availability of funds first.
