ACCESSIBILITY TAC May 13, 2003 Rosen Plaza Hotel, Orlando, Florida

The meeting convened at 2:00 P.M. and a quorum was present. The TAC approved the agenda and the minutes from the April 7, 2003 meeting.

GOALS: The following goals were identified for the remainder of 2003.

- 1. Identify discrepancies between DOT requirements and the Florida Accessibility Code.
- 2. Promote sensitivity training with licensing boards and professional associations.
- 3. Clarify areas of the codes where unclear; coordinate accessibility code with other codes.
- 4. Develop commentary for Florida specific areas of the code.
- 5. Foster more public involvement with the Accessibility TAC.

FAIR HOUSING: Legal will continue to research the local building officials' responsibility and authority to enforce Fair Housing requirements.

VERTIUCAL ACCESSIBILITY: Legal sill continue to research enforcement of vertical accessibility and use of exceptions.

MEMBERSHIP: Pursue appointment of persons to fill three TAC vacancies.

PARKING SIGNS: The TAC will develop a process to incorporate the parking sign mounting height into the code. DOT will be invited to participate.

AGENDA: The agenda was set for the July meeting.

ADVERTISING MEETINGS: To help foster more public participation, staff will contact professional groups and associations to place meeting notices in their periodicals.
