Review Senate Bill 442: Building Code Education and Outreach Council

Senate Bill 442 replaces the current Education TAC with the Building Code Education and Outreach Council. The Council will be composed of 12 members: 3 FBC representatives, one of which represents persons with disabilities; one representative of each of the individual licensing boards, totaling 7; 1 representative from the Fire Marshal's Office; and 1 representative of K-12 public school construction. Each member will be appointed for a 2-year term. The Chair will be elected from the appointed members.

DCA will provide administrative support to the Council.

Council's responsibilities will be: consider and determine policies and procedures required to administer s.489.109(3) and s.489.509(3); determine the areas of priority to expend funds for education and outreach; and, review proposed subjects for advanced courses.

Commission Action: Approve the following, with following conditions: (1) Clarify Exposure D does not apply to coast of Florida and (2) window film needs to be removed or condition of use clarified (tested for small, but not large, missile impact)
