SEARCHING FOR MODS







To search for a *Proposed Code Modification* navigate your browser to the BCIS - <u>www.floridabuilding.org</u>. You should see a page with a large blue menu on the left.

Click "*Proposed Code Modifications*". This should pull up a new menu screen.

To find a Mod, select *Find a Proposed Code Modification*. Here a search screen should load.

Note: There is no need to register or log in to search. To comment on a mod, registration is required (See "Registration" section of quide)


SEARCHING FOR MODS CONTINUED

- 4 To search by *Mod #* you have *two options*:
 - 1. Enter Florida Specific code change # (without prefix) into the :Modification #" entry field and hit "Search" example 4851

or

2. Enter ICC Modification number - enter ICC Modification number that can be alphanumeric and hit "Search" example RB39-19.


Mods can also be searched for by Technical Advisory Committee (i.e., Plumbing TAC, Special Occupancy TAC) and Subcode i.e., Building, Residential, Fuel-Gas

Note: To narrow down your results try using a combination of search parameters but remember not to use too many parameters to diminish your results to none.

Note: To select Chapter and Topic, select a Code Change Cycle First, and then Subcode



SUBMITTING COMMENTS



General comments can be submitted during the 45-day general comment period.

Note: General comments are limited to only a few paragraphs and one file upload.

Note: General Comments are shown as <u>modnumber-G1, -G2, etc. The "G" is generated</u> by the system to indicate it is an "General" comment.

Note: The pages of the application are on a timer that will time the mod out if no saving or action is being done in 15 minutes (typing in the box will not update the timeout).

You may lose your material if you don't save in progress often or work locally on a word processor

REGISTRATION



Registration on the BCIS is required for submitting comments for the ICC review process. Registration also allows notices and meeting information periodically sent to the email address in the system.

Note: If you intend to submit comments for code modifications it is recommended to register if you have not already. The process is easy, and the next few steps will guide you through the process.

New Users - You can register by clicking at the top of the BCIS page "User Registration". Here you will enter all of your contact information, including an email address that you check often.

Returning Users - Returning users only need to click on login and enter their login and password. There is a "forgot password" feature if you have forgotten your password. The forgot password feature will email you a temporary password to your registered email address. Contact us if you have forgotten your user login or not receiving the email.
