RE: EQUIVALENCE OF PUBLISHED AND ADOPTED VERSION OF TAS 100

Mr. Dyble:

Product testing may be deemed noncompliant to the 2023 Florida Building Code because the testing was performed to a version of the TAS 100 specification that is not a referenced standard in the code. This issue occurs frequently in the testing and certification industry as there are several building codes or recognized voluntary standards that unfortunately utilize different reference standards.

The issue at hand is whether the testing performed to TAS 100 is equivalent to the referenced TAS 100-23 standard in the 2023 Florida Building Code. I have reviewed both TAS specifications and have determined that the testing performed to TAS 100-95 satisfies all requirements of TAS 100-23.
